

◆ **Aftermarket Auto Care**

There are many aftermarket auto care products and chemicals which may be regulated as hazardous materials including, but not limited to:

- cleaning compounds
- waxes & polishes
- wheel bright
- fuel system additives
- window etch kits



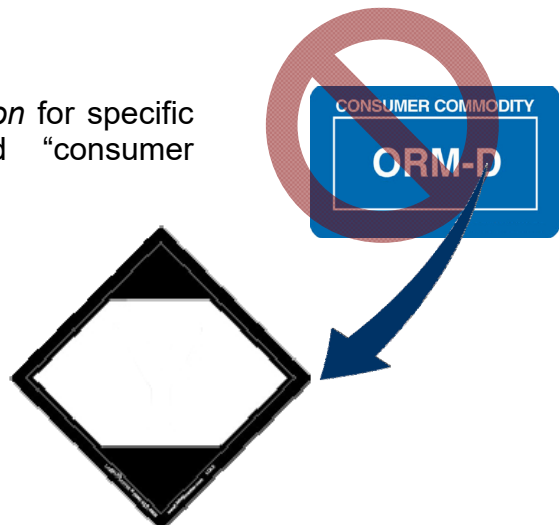
◆ **Consumer Commodities**

Consumer commodities are limited quantities of hazardous materials that are distributed in a form intended or suitable for retail distribution. These hazardous materials were formerly referred to as Consumer Commodity and reclassified as ORM-D (Other Regulated Materials).



HOWEVER, as of January 1, 2021, the term ORM-D is no longer authorized and has been replaced with the LTD QTY marking.

◆ **Small and Excepted Quantities Shipments**

Some aftermarket auto care products, such as window etch kits, adhesives or sealants may be entitled to significant regulatory relief if they are packed in inner packaging which do not exceed 30 ml (1 fluid ounce).

These substances may be transported under the small quantity (surface) provisions provided the requirements of 49 CFR § 173.4 are fully met.
